Friday, May 31, 2019 – Oak Brook, Illinois

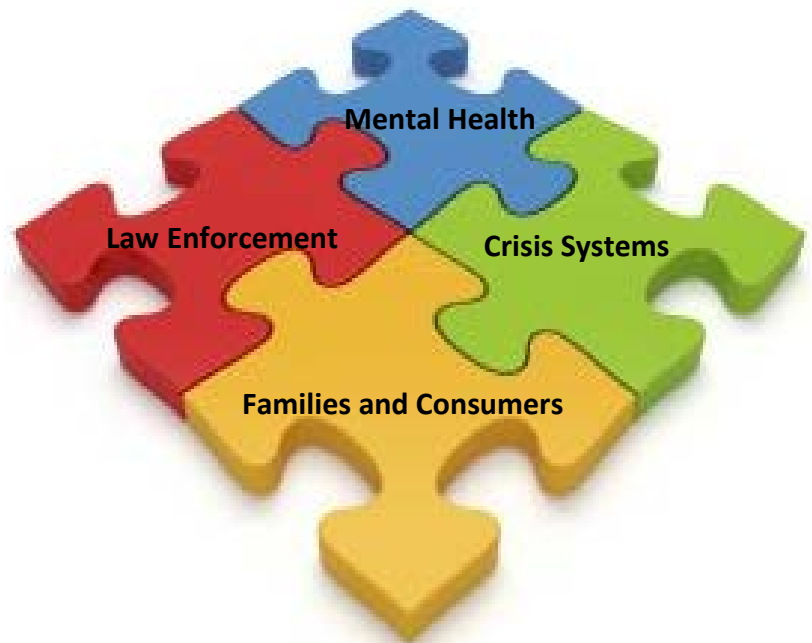
